If You Have a Model/Serial Number

You will find your computer's model/serial number on a label affixed to your computer's original packaging.

If you have your computer's model/serial number ready, please follow the steps below to obtain the part number for your battery, which will enable you to find the corresponding MSDS.

- 1. Open the parts service page: <u>https://support.lenovo.com/us/en/partslookup</u>
- 2. Under "Parts Lookup" select "By Product Info" from the dropdown (screenshot below):

- 3. Where it says "Example: 00HN925," enter your product model/serial number and hit Enter on your keyboard
